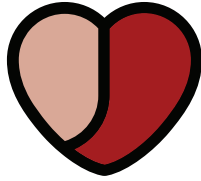


Donation Guidelines

All donated items must be in good, clean, sellable condition. We do not repair, refinish or reupholster. Goodwill has developed the following ●**REDLIGHT**●**GREENLIGHT** guidelines to help increase the amount of “sellable” donations received.



●**REDLIGHT**

Unacceptable:

- Automotive Parts
- Blinds
- Carpeting, Carpet Pads
- Construction Materials
- Food, Beverages (including alcohol)
- Gas Powered Tools and Garden Equipment
- Hospital Beds, Waterbeds, Air Mattresses
- Infant Equipment (cribs, playpens, changing table, car seats, walkers, strollers, high chairs, etc.)
- Major Appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- Mattresses, Box Springs, Mattresses in Sofa Beds
- Plumbing Fixtures
- Recyclables (paper, glass, plastic, aluminum)
- Water Heaters

- HAZARDOUS AND DANGEROUS WASTE***
- Bio-hazardous Materials (catheters, IVs, syringes, etc.)
- Fireworks, Explosives
- Flammable/Toxic Chemicals and Materials (acids/bases, aerosols, cleaning products, gasoline, liquid propane, mercury, mixed solutions, motor oil, paint, pesticides, pool chemicals, etc.)
- Weapons (Guns, Knives, Ammunition, Swords, Crossbows, Arrows, Spears, etc.)
- Medical Equipment (bed pans, portable potty, etc.)
- Medications (pills, creams, liquids, etc.)

●**GREENLIGHT**

Acceptable:

- Antiques, Collectibles
- Artwork, Frames
- Audio/Visual Equipment
- Bedspreads, Blankets, Linens, Fabric
- Bicycles, Wheeled Toys
- Books
- CDs, DVDs, Records, Audio and VHS tapes
- Clothing, Shoes, Accessories
- Computers, Printers, Accessories (working or not)
- Cookware, Dishware, Utensils
- Crafts (packaged sets)
- Drapes (no rods or hardware)
- Electronics (radios, stereos, small appliances)
- Exercise Equipment
- Furniture (sofas, tables, chairs, dressers, etc.)
- Giftware and Knickknacks
- Glassware
- Holiday Decorations
- Jewelry
- Lamps
- Sporting Goods, Sleeping Bags
- Televisions (no consoles)
- Tools (only hand tools and small power tools)
- VCRs, DVRs

**These items are strictly forbidden due to environmental regulations and/or safety concerns.*
