Goodwill Southern California To Host 2 Vote Centers For 2020 Presidential Election

Los Angeles, CA, October 21, 2020 – Two Goodwill Southern California campuses will serve as Vote Centers for the 2020 presidential election:

Goodwill Community Enrichment Center (Glassell Park) 3150 N. San Fernando Rd. Los Angeles 90065

Goodwill San Fernando Valley Campus 14565 Lanark Street Panorama City 91402

The two sites will be accessible with free parking to any registered voter in Los Angeles County over a five-day period from Monday, October 30 – Tuesday, November 3 (Election Day).

"For over 100 years, Goodwill Southern California has, through our employment programs, retail stores and donation centers, had a tradition of engagement with the Los Angeles community," said Patrick McClenahan, President and CEO of Goodwill Southern California. "Voting is our civic duty and we are pleased to work with Los Angeles County to do whatever we can to make it easy, safe and convenient for community members to vote."

Goodwill SoCal's Community Enrichment Center (Glassell Park) contains a Retail Store, Outlet Store, and Donation Center. Voting will be held in its Community Room where voters will have a large indoor space to vote where they can also practice social distancing. Free parking will be available in the parking lot. Face coverings are required.

Goodwill SoCal's San Fernando Valley Campus in Panorama City contains an Outlet Store, Donation Center, Youth Program and office space. Voting will be held in the Cafeteria, a large indoor space. Free street parking is available at this location. Face coverings are required.
