

## Wednesday


- 1. Secure the stencil tightly to the pumpkin.
  - Tip: Use tape all around the edges of the stencil.
- 2. Using a thumbtack, poke holes 1/8 inch apart all around the borders of the stencil. Remove the stencil to reveal the pattern.
  - Tip: If you can't see the pattern, sprinkle some flour on the outline and wipe away to see it clearly
- 3. Using a small carving tool, carve out the area starting in the middle of the stencil and working your way to the outside edges last.
- 4. Clean up the edges if necessary.



Cousin It

- 1. Cut out the stencil using a pair of scissors.






Thing
